

Instructions: Use this sheet to record behavior observations. Try to note what happened right before (Antecedent), what the behavior looked like (Behavior), and what happened immediately after (Consequence). This helps identify patterns and understand the "why" behind behaviors.

Definitions:

- Antecedent (A): What happened right before the behavior?
  - Example: The Teacher asked the student to clean up.
- Behavior (B): What the person did.
  - Example: The student screamed and threw the toy.
- Consequence (C): What happened right after the behavior?
  - Example: The student was sent to the hallway.
